#### **Introduction:**

We have established the academy in 2001 and is registered as a public liability company and is approved by the Director of Merchant Shipping in Sri Lanka to conduct Marine Courses. The academy employs qualified lecturers and is managed by a pioneer in maritime training, Capt. E.S.M.Senenayake who has obtained MSc in Maritime Training from World Maritime University–Sweden. He has been responsible in commencement of Marine short courses in Sri Lanka from 1988 and is a founder member of two other Maritime training institutes in Sri Lanka.

Lanka Academy of Technological Studies has obtained ISO 9001 – 2008 Standards which is mandatory for Maritime training academies and all courses conducted are supervised by the Director General of Merchant Shipping.

There is a worldwide shortage of trained seafarers and specially Sri Lankan seafarers are in demand and presently recruiting companies are finding it difficult to find trained seafaring officers to meet the demand.

Therefore we have embarked on a programme to train Navigating Watch Keeping officers restricted for 3000 GT sailing on Near Coastal Voyages (Class 4) and Navigating Watch Keeping Officer Restricted to 500 GT sailing on Near Coastal Voyages (Class 5) ranks as those ranks are high in demand.

A Class 5 certificated officer can earn over US\$1200/= per month and Class 4 certificated officer can earn over US\$1500/= per month and depending upon the ability of the individual, They can qualify to higher ranks such as Class 3, 2 and 1 where they can even earn over US\$ 5000/= per month.

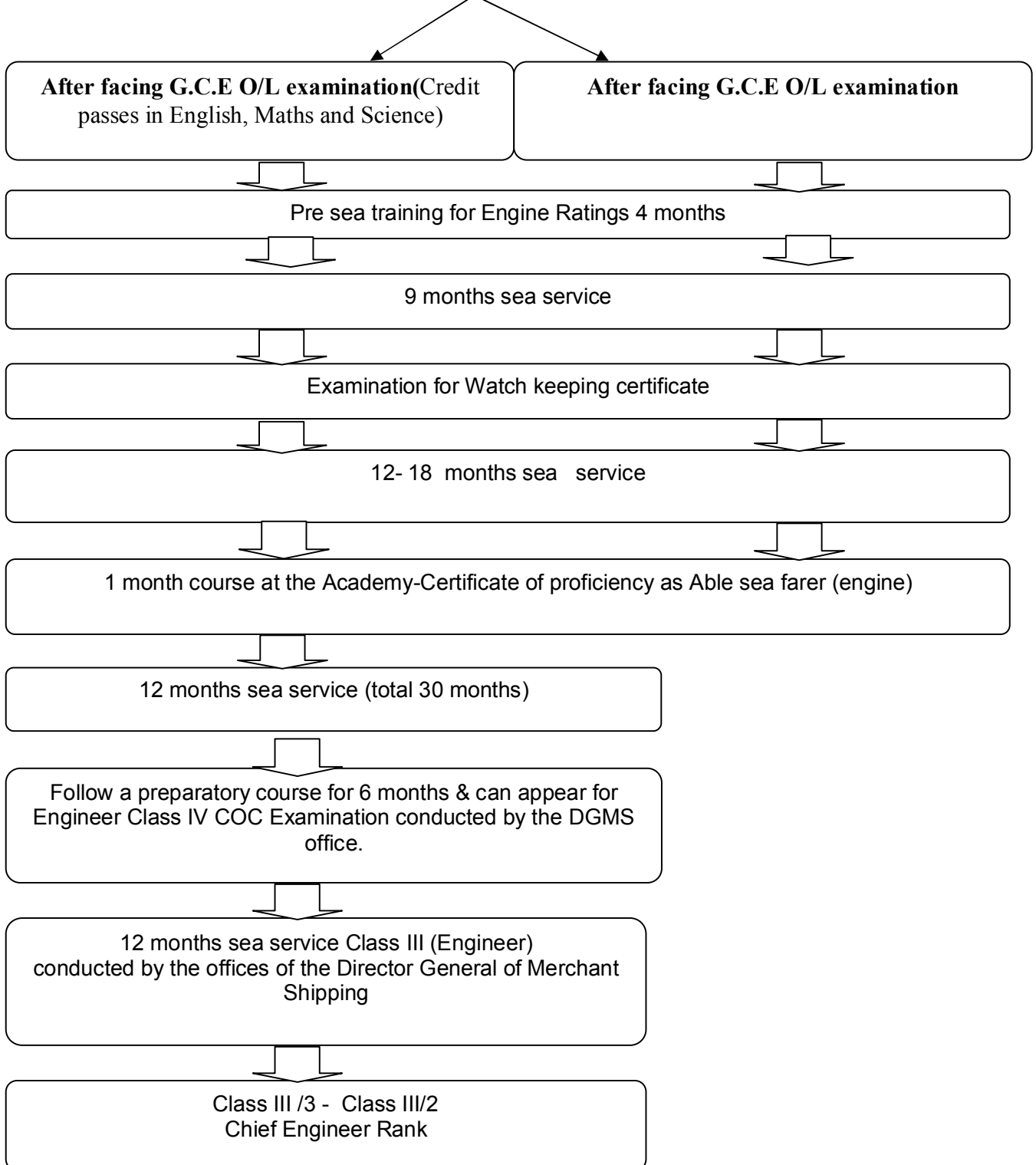

**Step 1 - Pre sea training****3 months + 1 Months (short Courses)**

**Total Course Fee- Rs. 75000/=**

The Selected candidate will follow residential pre sea training including basic safety courses at the academy. They will be trained on Physical Fitness, Introduction to Motor Engines, Ship Construction, Workshop Training , Refrigeration, Basic Electricity and Basic Safety Courses which are essential. 95% attendance compulsory.

The Trainees who Follows this phase of Training successfully will be issued with Continuous Discharge Certificate (CDC) by the Director General of Merchant Shipping.

**Step 2 - Sea training 12 months**

This phase will be At sea and we will assist you to find a vessel for board training. We have been assured berths for some, but we cannot guarantee placement on the ship. This task remains the responsibility of the trainee. Whilst at sea you will be paid an allowance by the ship owner.

Ensure you follow the Training requirements as given in the Deck Rating Training Book which will be available at your Academy.

Ensure you get Steering Certificate issued by Master of the Ship after showing your ability to steer the ship at sea.

**Step 3 - Shore based training**

Those who have completed 9 months of sea service will be able to sit for oral examination for Watch Keeping Certificate.

With Watch keeping Certificate in hand, you will find it easier to secure jobs on ships.

If you think it is necessary to come for Training before sitting for Watch Keeping Certificate test conducted by Director General of Merchant Shipping, you can follow .... Week course at our academy.

**Step 4 - Sea training 12 months**

As Assistant to Navigational Officer.

**Step 5 - Shore based training - 1 month**

**Able Seafarer - Engine**

**Course fee :LKR 52,000/-**

Those who have completed 12 months sea service as assistant to Navigational Watch Keeping Officer on ships can enroll for courses for Able Seafarer and get certificate of Competency as Able seafarer which will be mandatory for continuation of sea carrier as Able Seafarer ( AB)

**Step 6 – 12 months sea service or total 36 months sea service.****Step 7 – Certificate of Competency as Officer of watch**

After getting total of 36 months sea service, you are eligible to follow 6 months of classes leading to Class 3 – Certificate of Competency after which, you can secure job on ships as 3rd or 2nd Officer. Thereafter you can get more sea service and sit for examinations for Captain of Ships of various sizes.

**STEP 8:-** On completion of another 12months sea service you can appear for the Engineer class III conducted by the offices of the Director General of Merchant Shipping.

**STEP 9:-After appearing for** Class III /3 and Class III/2 examinations you can go up to Chief Engineer rank
